

2011 NEW RULE CHANGES:

1. On pages 31 & 34, Change the Region name from "Region One" To "Central Region".
2. On page 34, Change the rider letter designation from "M" to "A".
3. Page 54 Position of Time Clocks ; In all events except barrels, two poles 30 feet apart shall designate the start and finish line. In barrels, the starting poles shall be 60 feet apart. A horse must pass between these poles at the start and finish or be off course. Photocell and light to be on [the line with starting poles, set behind photocell, as close as possible to the on course.](#)
4. Page 58, under disqualifications: #5 added Intentional striking of a horse on the head, once given the course will be a disqualification to the rider.
5. Page 71 under Cowhide Event :Hide rider must be prone, sitting, [kneeling or have at least one knee on the ground](#) and have contact with the hide or rope before he crosses the mount line. No knots, [ties or twists](#) permitted.
6. [Page 85 Under State Show Approval: Show management has the option of using electronic arena sheets. Timer or Secretary would be able to enter times into a computer as they were run and backup handwritten list will be kept. At the end of the class the sheet will be printed for judges and timers signatures and posted for riders. Scanned copies of show sheets can be submitted to times keeper by email. Hard copies will be sent to the state times keeper.](#)
7. Page 85 Under State Show Approval: WHO Shows: Western Horsemen of Oregon (WHO) approved games shows [to](#) be included in averages for PSHA. Times must be submitted by the rider on the approved form to the PSHA timeskeeper. Times must be postmarked within 72 hours except for the last [weekend, when](#) times must be postmarked within 24 hours. To be accepted, 60 cents per ride must be included and either the show steward or the show chairman must initial the form. Forms will be available on the website or upon request from the state office. [A copy of the entry form must be attached to the PSHA Form and fees will be paid on every event entered at a rate of .60 per ride.](#) Times will not count for PSHA records. (The Rules Committee determined that Team Poles must be run with a baton.) [Penalties noted as "plus 5" to be noted as a no time on the PSHA Form. Any rider competing at the PSHA State Championship show must compete for WA at the OR/WA Interstate show.](#)
8. [Page 87 under PostPoned Shows : A show that has been postponed due to rain and the show must start later to let the arena dry and any event that cannot be run in the order listed in the PSHA newsletter due to safety can be run at the end of the show if the arena becomes safe when show management](#)

and the steward chooses to do so. If multiple events are in effect they must be run in the original (published) order.
