2011 Annual Meeting Rule Changes as amended and passed

PAGE 33 Sec. 2 General Rules

Part A. I propose to change Part A to ----The show season begins August 1st. of current year and ends July 31st. of the next year. The membership year is to run from August 1st. ----July 31st, each year. Members must pay PSHA membership dues before their times will count for the New Year.

PAGE 33 Sec. 2 General Rules

Part C. I propose to insert after sentence #3---Regions will not renew a permanent number or give out a new permanent number unless the rider is a paid member of PSHA.

PAGE 36 Letter G RULES COMMITTEE PURPOSE:

#4 letter d. I propose to change in the first sentence ---“20 days”.

PAGE 37 Letter H. PROTEST RULES:

#1 letter b. I propose to add sentence ---If a team is involved in the protest, the President must inform the team captain who in turn will inform his/her team members.

I move that on page 37 "H. PROTEST RULES: # 1

Change to read: 1. Any member wishing to file a protest must do so within 48 hours of a judge's call or hearing of an administrative decision. A written description of the circumstances accompanied by a \$25.00 deposit must be filed with the President.

I move to change Page 54 #6 last sentence to read:

"Photocell and light to be on the line in front of the starting poles. Attaching the photocell and light to the poles with clamps would be acceptable."

PAGE 56 Section 5: COMPETITION GENERAL RULES

Letter A. #17 I propose to add new sentence #3---The team captain is responsible for checking the other members of his/her's team for current years PSHA membership.

PAGE 90, Section I, number 1, to read:

State Finals Championships first place plaques or buckles to be awarded at the State Finals Championship show or PSHA Annual Meeting and Recognition given to the next 5 places. In the event of a tie for first place, a second plaque will be purchased and awarded at the PSHA Annual Meeting and first place points will also be awarded to both recipients.
